On July 31, Odebrecht S.A., Atvos, Braskem, Ocyan, Odebrecht Engineering & Construction and OR signed the “**Letter of Commitment to the Business Movement for Integrity and Transparency**”, which is an initiative led by the Ethos Institute in partnership with the UN Global Compact and Transparency International.

We are pleased to say that we have participated since 2017 in the construction of this movement, which was supported by contributions from members of our Global Advisory Council convened in October of that year.

The movement’s goal is to engage business leaders in the integrity agenda, with a special focus on improving public-private relations and strengthening measures to prevent and combat corruption in Brazil.
